



Have a tea with white rabbit, take a picture with the Hatter and let yourself be amazed with all the little wonderland's details.






The whole world of wonders is filled with curious creatures, plants and objects. You can meet them on your wanderings, behind every corner of the maze.

Touch, see, hear and smell the magic...





When you get through the mist and pass along the luminous mushrooms, sparkling flowers and windy trees, there will be a hidden passage waiting for you.








“But I don't want to go among mad people,” Alice remarked.
