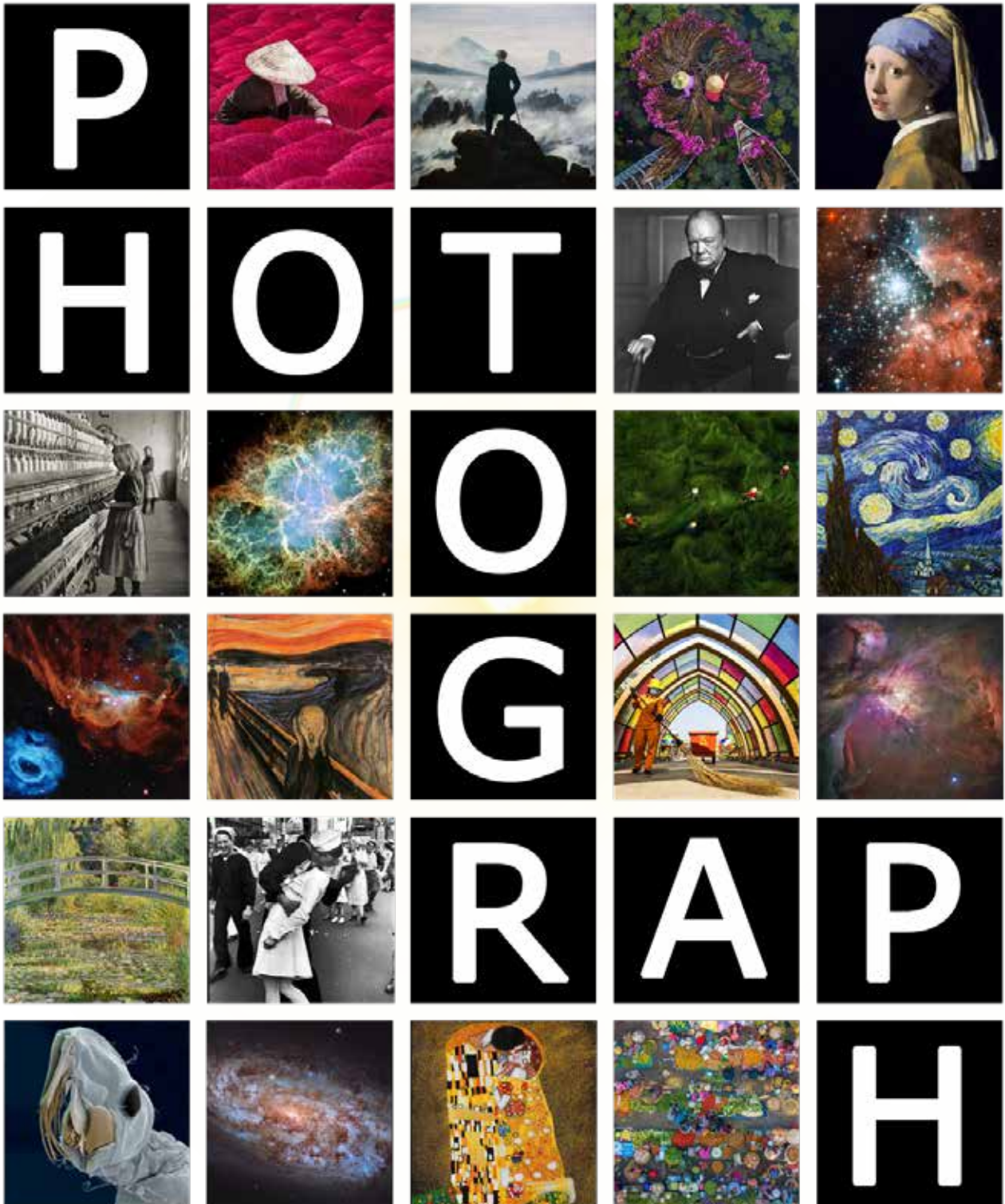

Photography exhibition that will open your eyes







We live in times when the visual pollution spread so much, that the phrase itself has a whole new meaning. And in the times like these, it is more important than ever to show people something meaningful.

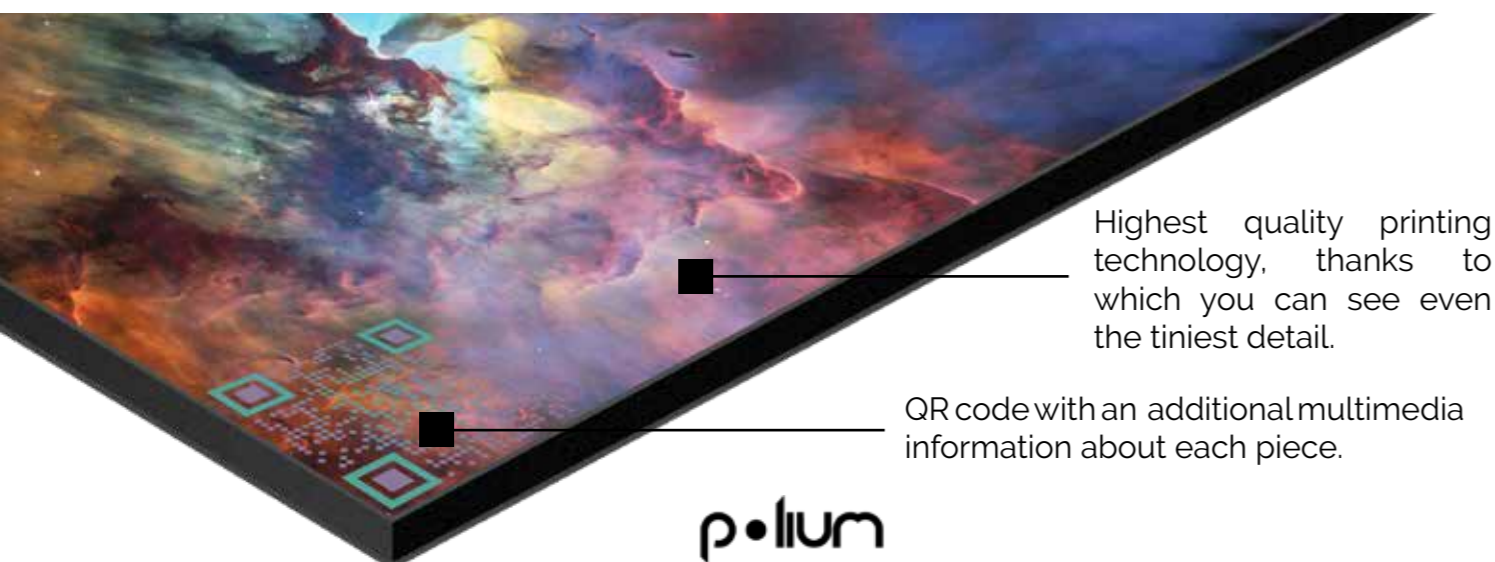

However, the most important item, except of the images themselves, is the added value of information.

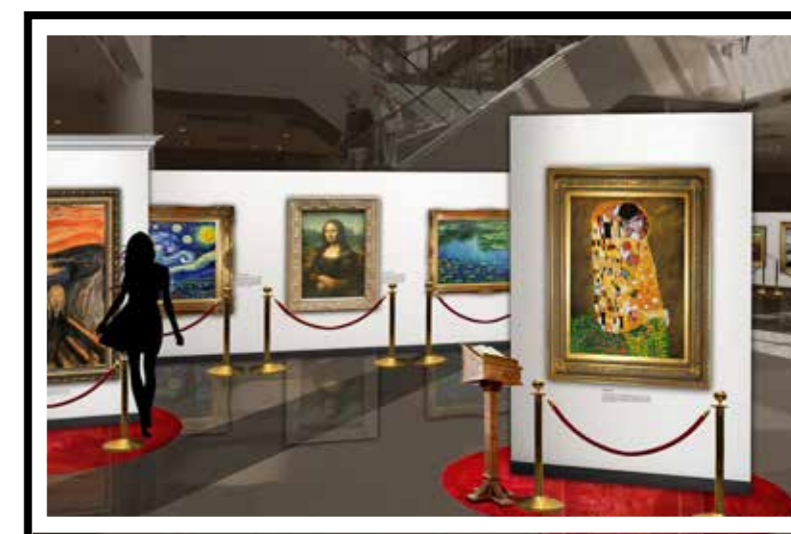


No one likes to read boring information boards with almost no relevant information anymore.

By one simple scan with your smartphone, you can get as little or as much information as you would like. You can find out just the name of the image, or you can dive into deep study of space...



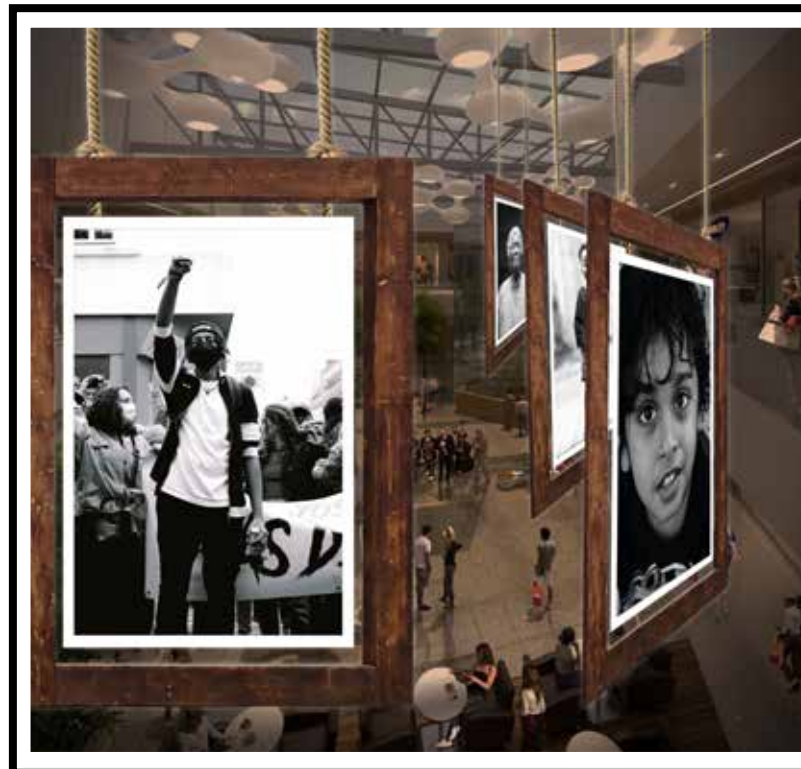
